



Graduate Student Annual Conference Scholarship 2012 Conference – Ft. Lauderdale, FL

Presented to selected TASS attendees who are pursuing graduate education at either the Master's, Ph.D., or Ed.D. level, this grant which will give selected individuals whose inquiry is related to theme of success for underprepared and underserved students an opportunity to attend the 23rd Annual Teaching Academic Survival Skills Conference in Ft. Lauderdale, FL. The scholarship will cover the cost of the registration fee to attend the conference.

Eligibility

The applicant must:

- be currently enrolled in an accredited graduate program related to student success
- not be employed full-time
- demonstrate interest in the success of underprepared or underserved students

Application materials:

- a one to two-page letter addressed to the review committee that describes the applicant's research interest, academic and professional goals. This letter should articulate how TASS conference attendance might further these goals and support the applicant's engagement in student success efforts.
- a brief CV
- one letter of support by a faculty member from the applicant's field
